

Winter Shelter Instructions

Community Cat Program

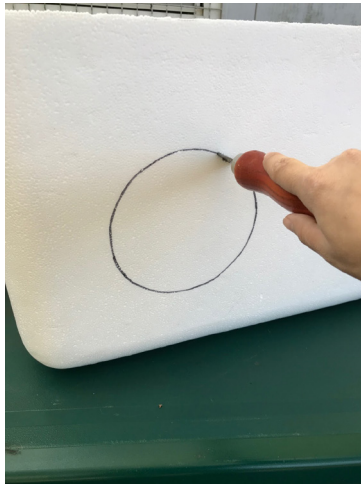


Supplies You Will Need:

- Large styrofoam cooler (e.g. Huskee 48 can cooler from Walmart or ask your local grocery store or vet's office)
- Utility knife
- Piece of scrap wood (1x1 or 2x2 works best, Try Turnip Green Creative ReUse)
- Yard sign (Try Turnip Green Creative ReUse)
- Heavy Duty Adhesive - Liquid Nails
- Straw

Step 1:

First, cut a 6" circle 4" from the left and bottom of the cooler. Making a quick template can



Step 2:

Next, punch a hole in the front corner of the cooler for drainage using your utility knife.



Step 3:

Use the yard sign to line the bottom inside of the cooler. You can use your utility knife to cut the flooring. Then place the new floor inside the cooler.



Step 4:

Use adhesive to attach the wood under the right side of the cooler opposite the drainage hole and entry way. Allow this to dry for 24 hours.

Step 5:

Line the shelter with straw (NO HAY) deep enough for the cat to burrow in.



Step 6:

Replace the top your shelter is ready. We recommend placing something heavy on top of the cooler to keep the top in place.
